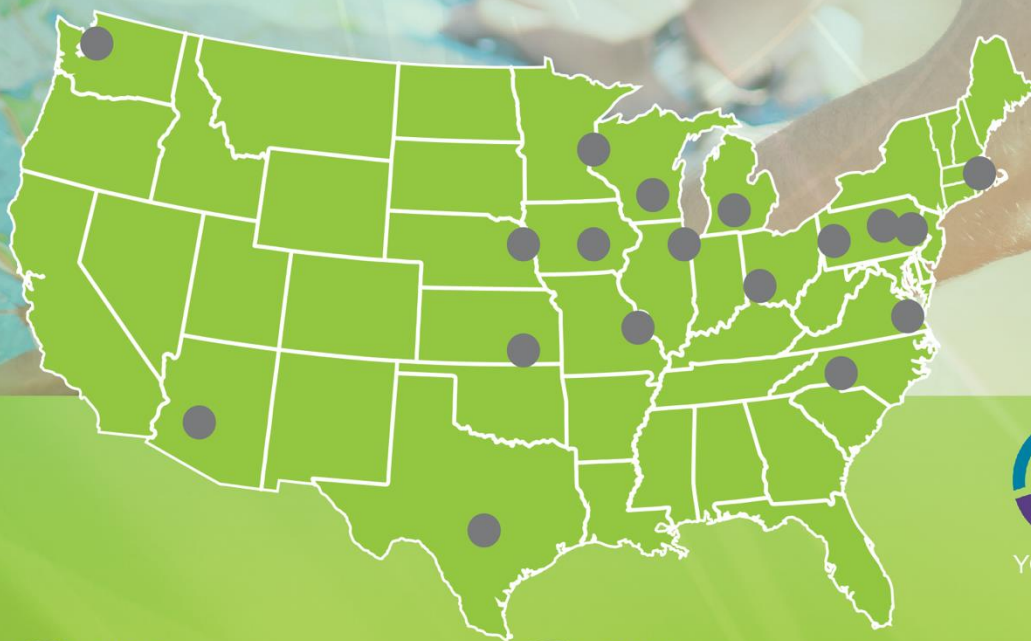

SOCIAL MEDIA KIT

If you are looking for ways to promote the upcoming Quake to your youth and/or congregation through social media, this Social Media Kit is for you.

You, an adult leader, adult volunteer, junior guide, or other selected individual, may use the included resources to promote Quake on social media to your youth and/or congregation. The social media tools and resources can be shared on church, youth group, or personal social media accounts, as well as included in worship service PowerPoints or slideshows. We encourage you to use them in the electronic manner that will be most beneficial to you and your group.

Included in this Social Media Kit:

Ready-made Facebook Posts

On the next page, you will find ready-made posts specific to your upcoming Quake that you can copy and paste to Facebook, or any other social media account you choose.

Post topics range from those that promote Quake to your youth, ask the congregation or community to pray for the youth as they prepare for the upcoming event, to posts regarding what to pack for the weekend.

Additionally, select posts include the event theme hashtag **#iamfound** and the Quake Facebook username, @YouthQuakes. (If sharing on Twitter or Instagram, use @QuakeEvents)

Ready-made posts can be used as is, edited, or simply to help generate post ideas of your own as you prepare to promote Quake to your youth and congregation.

Photo and Graphic Resources

- Included are several photos and graphic resources to help you share the excitement of the upcoming Quake with your youth.
- Images include:
 - Musician and/or speaker photos
 - Photos from past Quake events.
 - **FOUND** Logo
 - Photos of food packaging service project.
- Photos can be shared on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and more.
- Image format – this resource kit includes both rectangular and square images. Either of these formats can be shared on the above listed social media platforms. The rectangular images can be cropped into squares if that is your preferred format for sharing photos on Instagram.
 - * **Instagram** – the most common format is square. However, Instagram has a feature that allows the user to share a rectangular photo. Open Instagram on a mobile device, select the image to share, adjust the size of the image using fingers (**prior to clicking “Next” or entering the photo edit screen**) until the full rectangular image appears on the screen.
